(*Ps 102:25–27*) (*Mal 3:6, Num 23:19, James 1:17*) (*Ps 33:11, 119:89–90; Heb 6:17–18*)

Sometimes God appears to change his mind (*Ex 32:9–14; Isa 38:1–6; Jonah 3:4, 10*).
However, God's purposes do not change.
