*John 4:4–24*

That God is \_\_\_\_\_ is one of God's  
\_\_\_\_\_ attributes (*John 4:24*).

God does not have \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ (*Deut 4:12*).

God is revealed as the \_\_\_\_\_ God.  
(*1 Tim 1:17; 6:16; Rom 1:20; John 1:18; Col 1:15*)

No merely \_\_\_\_\_ object can show the likeness of God.  
(*Ex 20:4-5; Deut 4:15–26; Gen 1:26–27; Col 1:15*)

God is \_\_\_\_\_ (*Ps 139:7-12; Jer 23:23-24; 1 Kg 8:27; Is 66:1-2*).

However, God is *described* in \_\_\_\_\_ language, and interacts with men through visions and manifestations (*Ps 18:6–10; Gen 18:1–2; Ex 33:20–23*).

Because God is Spirit we:

“His worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth.” (*John 4:24 NIV*). Where we worship is not important, \_\_\_\_\_ we worship is.
